NOTIFICATION

No.ELC-1(1)/GBE/ 2020. WHEREAS Section 182 of the Elections Act 2017 imposes ban on convening, holding or attending any public meeting, or promoting or joining in any procession, within the area of a constituency during a period of forty-eight hours ending at midnight following the conclusion of the poll day.

AND WHEREAS, the General Elections 2020 to Gilgit-Baltistan Assembly are scheduled to be held on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of powers conferred upon him under section 182 of the Elections Act, 2017 (Act No. XXXIII), the Honorable Chief Election Commissioner Gilgit-Baltistan has been pleased to direct that no person shall convene, hold or attend any public meeting, or promote or join in any procession from midnight 12:00 AM, 13<sup>th</sup> November 2020 for a period of forty-eight hours with in 24 constituencies of Gilgit-Baltistan.
